Manufacturers position NuraPatch for people seeking targeted relief or ongoing support without daily pills — for example, users looking for joint comfort, energy support, mood balance, or sleep aid depending on the patch formulation. Patches are usually applied to a clean, dry area of skin and replaced on a schedule (daily, every 48–72 hours, or as directed).
